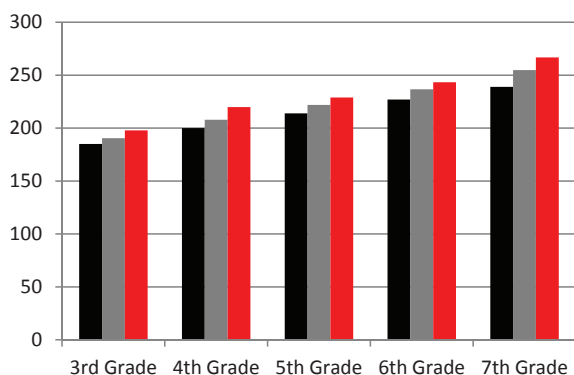

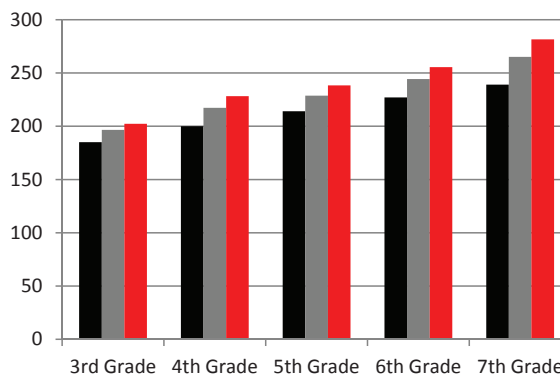
IOWA STANDARD AVERAGE SCORES MATH

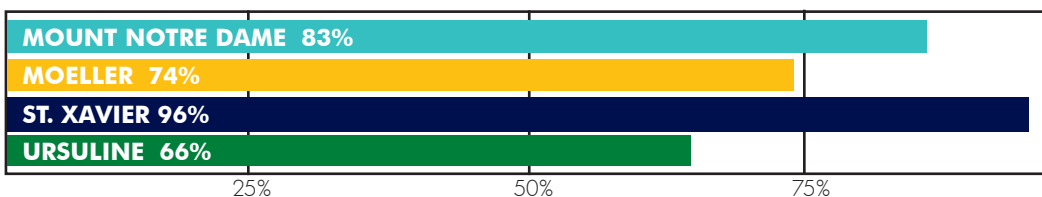
